## Sustainable Supported Living Costing Framework

#### Why This Tool Matters

Supported living for people with learning disabilities and autistic people is often underfunded, undervalued, and misunderstood. This tool changes that.

It helps providers and commissioners:

- Understand the true cost of delivering high-quality support
- Benchmark fairly and transparently
- Negotiate with confidence
- Plan sustainably for the future

Built on real-world data from More Than a Provider partners - Brandon Trust, Certitude, Choice Support, Dimensions, MacIntyre, and United Response - it reflects the real-world complexity of supported living; not just the numbers, but the people behind them.

#### What the Tool Does

It calculates fair and sustainable hourly rates for:

- Daytime support (shared, 1:1, or both)
- Waking night support
- Sleep-in shifts
- Specialist/complex support
- Blended rates (day + night)

It also lets you:

- Tailor assumptions to your local context
- Price individual packages, schemes, or portfolios
- Compare current funding to fair cost
- Benchmark against national headline rates

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## What Makes It Different?

- Built by and for the sector - not-for-profit providers, not consultants
- Evidence-based - grounded in benchmarked data
- Flexible and transparent - you control the assumptions
- Designed for action - supports bids, negotiations, and strategic planning

## Who Should Use It?

- Providers: To understand true costs, support bids, and negotiate fair rates
- Commissioners: To benchmark pricing and shape sustainable markets
- Finance and Operational Teams: To model scenarios and plan budgets
- Policy Leads: To inform strategic decisions and advocacy

## Step-by-Step Walkthrough

### Step 1: Open the Tool and Go to the “Quick Rate Calculator” Tab (1a)

This is your starting point.

#### What to do:

- Enter your base hourly pay (e.g. RLW, NLW, NHS Band 3, LLW)
- Enter sleep-in shift pay (e.g. £55 per shift)
- Set nighttime hours (default is 10)
- Answer Yes/No to:
  - Apprenticeship levy
  - Void risk contingency
  - Bank holiday and weekend enhancements
  - Agency staffing provision

#### What you get:

- Fair hourly rates for:

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- Daytime support
- Waking night support
- Sleep-in shifts
- Specialist/complex support
- Blended rate (day + night)
- A full breakdown of staffing, overheads, and margin

## Step 2: Review or Edit Assumptions (Tab 1b)

This tab shows the detailed assumptions behind the rates.

### What to do:

- Review default assumptions
- Edit if needed to reflect your local contracts or policies:
  - NI, pension, training, sickness, recruitment
  - Senior support worker ratios
  - Service manager costs
  - Local and central overheads
  - Surplus margin (default: 2.5%)

**Tip:** Only edit if you have reliable local data. Defaults are robust and evidence based.

## To Cost an Individual Package (Tab 2):

Use this tab to calculate the fair cost for one person's support.

### What to do:

- Enter weekly hours for:
  - Shared daytime support
  - 1:1 daytime support
  - Specialist/complex support

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- Waking night support
- Sleep-in shifts

## What you get:

- Weekly and annual fair cost
- Comparison with current and proposed rates
- Clear breakdown by support type

## To Cost a Scheme or Service Location (Tab 3)

Use this tab to calculate the fair cost for a whole supported living scheme.

## What to do:

- Enter:
  - Number of residents
  - Total hours of support (shared, 1:1, specialist)
  - Number of waking night and sleep-in staff

## What you get:

- Weekly and annual fair cost of the scheme
- Average cost per resident
- Comparison with funded rates

## To Cost Build a Portfolio View (Tab 4)

Use this tab to assess multiple schemes together.

## What to do:

- Copy outputs from the Scheme tab
- Paste into the Portfolio tab
- Add notes and compare funded vs fair costs

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## What you get:

- RAG rating system:
  - **Green:** Fair funding (0–2% variance)
  - **Amber:** 2–10% variance
  - **Red:** >10% variance
- Total and average funding gaps

## To Benchmark Against National Rates (Tab 5)

This tab shows headline rates calculated from the MTAP methodology.

## What to do:

- Compare your local rates to national benchmarks
- Use this to support funding conversations and strategic planning
